You will be supported by Science World staff and may be paired with another developing educator. Working with the Program Manager of Future Science Leaders, you will create a 4 to 5 week curriculum on one of these themes:

Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Technology, Math, Earth & Space Sciences

Benefits

- Professional development, including workshops on developing inquiry-based activities and one on one mentorship with Science World educators
- Letters of acknowledgement and professional documentation for grants and supervisors.
- Future Science Leader fellowship certificate indicating commitment to science communication and leadership.
- Opportunities for networking with local scientists and communicators dedicated to public engagement with science.
- A modest honorarium paid upon the successful completion of your theme.
- Enjoy exhibit and OMNIMAX passes to share with family and friends and receive invitations to special events and social receptions.

Responsibilities

- Design the theme, including expert speakers and interactive activities
- Stay within budget for required supplies
- Supervise the planned sessions
- Complete reports on each session and the entire theme
- Attend monthly meetings for workshops and peer support

Qualifications:

- You have completed at least one year of graduate school in the sciences and/or completed at least one practicum in an education program.
- You are self-motivated, outgoing and approachable
- You are able to work in a team environment and able to adapt to changing roles and responsibilities
